

Alex Moore Park upgrade

Kia ora all,

You are receiving this update as you are a user of the Alex Moore turf. We are doing our best to accommodate players at alternative venues while this work is being carried out. We appreciate you working with us as we carry out these upgrades.

Contractors commenced work, setting up fencing at the beginning of October and creating a safe workspace in the vicinity of the artificial turf. With substantial time involved removing the rubber balls and sand, which has now been redistributed to the Riding for Disabled arena in Lower Hutt, the work has now moved on to the next phase. The artificial turf has been removed and testing on the shock pads under the turf has begun, to ensure it meets with NZ Football and Rugby regulations.

The new underlay will be laid across the shock pads over the next few weeks, followed by the new turf and further testing.

I know that the large area that has been cordoned off to house products and vehicles as they are needed, is inconvenient and the contractors will be doing their best to refine the space as they move through the project. Unfortunately, at this point in time, the area cordoned off is what is required.

The team are still tracking well to have this project completed by the end of the year – with testing following this.
